- 1. Dale circulated treasurer's report and said he filed the 990 form for nonprofits with the IRS. We have sufficient funds to support several projects for this year.
- 2. Julia reported that the RPCV Regional Campout, which WCPCA is organizing this year, has been scheduled for July 14-16 at South Beach, near Newport. Sam Greer will help with the organization. We need to set up a mechanism for individuals to sign up and pay for their campsite and one organized group meal.
- 3. Juliet reviewed the various events planned for 2017 starting with a March 19 potluck at the home of Juliet and Charles. Other events include: a June 1 Send-Off party at the University of Oregon, Gerlinger Hall; a Sunday, June 18, afternoon at the Eugene Emeralds ballpark; an August picnic; September/October Oktoberfest fundraiser at Ninkasi; possible October potluck; and December Story Slam event.
- 4. Juliet also mentioned the NCPA's "Protect Peace Corps Campaign" to urge local RPCV groups to advocate for saving PC's \$410 million budget and the International Affairs' \$60 billion budget. The Trump Administration has said it will cut the International Affairs budget, which includes PC, up to 37%. Their initial budget is due out on March 16.
- 5. Still no one has stepped up to fill the position of Newsletter Editor. An announcement will be made at the upcoming potluck.
- 6. Gary reports there are 7 2017 PC calendars left which he will bring to the 3/19 potluck.
- 7. Nicky will be sending a notice seeking RPCVs for the UO Street Fair in May, to assist her in promoting PC to students.

- 8. We have funds to donate to PCPP projects, but currently there are none of Oregon volunteers seeking financial support. Julia has ideas about urging Oregon PCVs to start one. There is a former So. Eugene HS student in Namibia, and a WCPCA member in Macedonia, Kathleen Conery, who volunteers at a school that needs educational supplies.
- 9. James recruits several board members to volunteer for Chef's Night Out, a Food for Lane County event that we typically help with take down and clean up at the Hult Center. It is 4/04/17, starting at 8:15 p.m.
